

## Awana Bible Club “Bring a Friend” Options

Each club at AWANA has a “Bring a Friend” requirement in order to pass a book section. This invitation should be for a non-church attending child. If they are a friend from another AWANA club, we defeat the purpose of the section, which is to reach unsaved boys and girls with the good news about Jesus! You are always welcome to invite believing friends to club, we love to help boys and girls to grow in their relationship in Christ, but remember that kids can reach out and share Jesus with unbelievers!

We understand that every family’s circumstances are different and your child may not be able to bring someone to fulfill this requirement, in that case we have made the following options available:

- 1) Clubbers can tell 5 unsaved friends about their AWANA club and invite them. *Help your child write their names down, you sign it, they can give it to their club leader to get signed off.*
- 2) Clubbers may wear his or her uniform to school or public event and answer questions they may be asked. *Help your child write their experience down & give it to their club leader to get signed off.*
- 3) Bring a non-church attending friend to your church event (Church, Sunday School, etc.) *Help your child write their experience down and turn this in to their club leader to get signed off.*
- 4) Pass out 25 Club Invitation flyers with the map, download at AWANA forms [calvarysac.org](http://calvarysac.org) *Let their leader know to sign them off.*
- 5) If your child has a spiritual conversation in which they engage another child or an adult with the gospel. *Help them write what was said down and give it to their leader to get signed off.*
